### **Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct**

All parents/guardians are expected to act in accordance with this Code of Conduct in their physical and online interactions with children and young people under the age of 18 years.

#### **As a Nook Dance Centre parents/guardian I will:**

- Unconditionally support the health and safety of all children at Nook Dance Centre.
- Speak with respect to all children, staff and teachers
  - No yelling
  - No indecent language
  - No abusive tone
  - No singling out
- Report any incidents of bullying, racism or abuse immediately to the studio owner (Tammy McLinden).
- Allow staff and teachers to make decisions in the best interest of my child(ren) and discuss any concerns privately and calmly with the teacher and/or studio owner.
- Encourage children at Nook Dance Centre in a positive and supportive manner.
- Be a positive member of Nook Dance Centre's community and offer support where possible.
- Keep my child(ren) home from dance class if they are unwell or injured and seek appropriate medical advice.
- Follow all codes of conduct in place for special events including our End-of-Year Show.
- Collect my child(ren) from classes and rehearsals on time and communicate with staff directly if running late.
- Respect the community spaces that our classes take place in and clean up any mess made by me or my child.



**As a Nook Dance Centre parent/guardian I will NOT:**

- Force my child to dance if they do not want to.
- Force my child to dance injured or sick.
- Speak negatively about the staff, teachers or Nook Dance Centre in a way that creates a toxic and unhealthy environment.

**A serious breach of this code of conduct may result in termination of enrolment at Nook Dance Centre.**

All Nook Dance Centre students are expected to act in accordance with this Code of Conduct while attending classes at Nook Dance Centre.

**As a Nook Dance Centre student, I will:**

- Treat all Nook Dance Centre staff and other parents/carers and students with respect.
- Arrive at class ready to focus and learn.
- Respect the spaces we dance in and the people who work in these spaces by packing away any toys, pencils, paper etc after use and cleaning up any messes/spills.
- Tell my teacher if I need to leave the studio/hall for any reason including to go to the toilet.
- Have a positive attitude and be open to trying new things.
- Leave my mobile phone in my bag (on silent) and tell my teacher if I need to use one during class (if applicable).
- Keep my hands to myself unless engaging in partner work during class.
- When dancing with a partner or group during class, I will treat my partner/group members with respect and check in with them regularly to ensure they feel safe. I will tell my partner/group if I want them to stop touching me at any time during partner/group work.
- Tell my teacher or another adult if I ever feel unsafe in my dance class for any reason.
